Special Notice:

At our Museum Staff meeting last week it was decided that we would like to do more planetarium shows than the one per month we have done recently. (I have been advocating this for years.)

Are any of you interested in learning how to operate the planetarium instrument (very simple) and putting on a show, probably once a month? This is a paid position.

Do you know anyone who might be interested? The show is put on at 3pm and runs typically about 45 minutes. Audiences are limited to 50 people and no children under age 5 are admitted. Typically there are many children included, so you have to pitch your talk to an intermediate level which will keep their interest. The main topic of each month's show is a PowerPoint prepared by our main planetarium presenter Cal Powell, so all you need to do is elaborate a bit, or just go to showing the current evening sky. Of course one also has to answer questions, usually after the show.
